I'M SENTIMENTAL dueled early from outside, shook loose on the turn, extended his lead in upper stretch and held sway under intermittent urging. TONE OF GOLD chased the leaders from outside to the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the rest. SPIN TIME failed to threaten while racing wide throughout. DREAM TRIPPER dueled early along the inside then gave way leaving the turn. POPULAR KAT raced four wide to the turn, was carried six wide into the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. WHATIS IS raced within striking distance to the top of the stretch and lacked a further response. THE DRUID was never a factor. SANDY SHOES trailed throughout.
