ACTCENTUATE showed speed along the inside, was headed by PURE WILD inside the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. PURE WILD chased the pace along the rail, slipped through inside ACTCENTUATE to get a head in front but was outfinished. PRINCESS ALERT outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. REASONTOFLY chased the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. NATASHA'S RENO advanced three wide on the turn to reach contention but had no late response. NIEBLA failed to menace. MOOCHIE TOO chased the pace into the stretch and tired. PHAEDRA was outrun. DOTS N DASHES saved ground and faded.
