SAN DARE trailed to the turn, circled five wide into the stretch then closed strongly in the middle of the track to get up in the final strides. CALISTA (GB) reserved early, waited patiently for room on the turn, closed strong to gain a slim lead in deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. LAURICA checked entering the backstretch, trailed on the turn, raced in traffic while gaining in midstretch then rallied belatedly. REMEDIATE saved ground to the turn, slipped through along the rail in upper stretch and finished willingly. WANDER MOM never far back, split horses to threaten in upper stretch and weakened late. AMONITA (GB) raced three wide to the turn and flattened out. NOTABLE CRAFT raced up close to the turn and faded. ABUELA ESTHER (URU) stalked three wide for six furlongs and tired. MIMI'S TIZZY was used for forcing the early pace. ALLAMERICAN BERTIE set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch and gave way.
