FOLLOW ME HOME set a rapid pace slightly off the rail into upper stretch, extended her lead in midstretch then held off SOMETHING SILVER under strong right hand urging. SOMETHING SILVER never far back, took up chased after the winner while three wide leaving the turn then closed gradually but could not get up. HOUSE PARTY hit the side of the gate while breaking slowly, rapidly gained while splitting horses on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. MARY MURPHY dueled early inside the winner, dropped back slightly while saving ground on the turn then finished evenly. D' NILE settled just off the early pace, rallied four wide to reach contention on the turn then flattened out. HOME RUN HITTER failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. HUMMEL never reached contention.
