WYATT'S WOMEN stalked the pace, slipped through inside SHANGHAI SWEETIE to gain the lead leaving the turn, then drew away under urging. QUEEN SHENNO unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while unable to stay with the winner. SEABROOK CHARMER rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to reach the attending position in the stretch, then gave way. MAJESTIC MOUNTAIN outrun after breaking awkwardly, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the show. FAMILY CREDIT vied for the lead three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. SHANGHAI SWEETIE vied for the lead between horses to the top of the stretch, then faltered. SINCERE BELIEVER vied for the lead along the rail, then was dropping back when checked nearing the quarter pole and faded.
