DA' TARA well handled while making the pace off the rail, increased his advantage in midstretch and remained clear to the wire under urging. TIZZY chased the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while saving the place. BAYSTREET BULLY allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied to just miss the place. SIR JOCK rated off the pace, advanced along the inside around the far turn to loom a threat but had no late response. COVE STAR unhurried after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals in the drive. HENNESY EXPRESS failed to menace after being outrun early. TIZWAY off slowly, raced in striking position along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. CARSON HALL chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. POLITICAL EMPIRE was done early and eased in the stretch run. LORD AND T. tracked the pace for a half mile, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
