FINAL MESA chased the pace three wide, moved to take over at the quarter pole, then edged away through the stretch while drifting in a bit. POMEROYS PISTOL chased the pace along the rail, made a run to try FINAL MESA leaving the turn and into the stretch, then was weakening when angled outside the winner at the sixteenth pole. ROXY GAP reserved off the pace after being bumped at the start, raced four wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. IT'S ME MOM showed speed off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. QUANTUM MISS stumbled and bumped ROXY GAP at the start, chased the pace four wide, made a run to reach the leaders at the quarter pole, then faltered in the drive. MIS VIZCAYA well placed along the rail into the turn, faded.
