**Footnotes**

ZA APPROVAL stalked leaders along inside in backstretch, made a three wide bid heading into turn, edged up to JOES BLAZING AARON midstretch, dug in gamely and outnodded rival at wire. JOES BLAZING AARON raced up close tracking early leader, edged up along outside of TELL TALE FRIEND heading into turn, took command at the top of the lane, challenged by ZA APPROVAL midstretch, continued to dig in and just missed at the wire. HYPER reserved in early going racing in back of rivals, steadily gained position in deep backstretch, raced five wide at top of the lane and quickly gained ground in stretch. SILVER ROCK settled along inside in backstretch, slightly gained position going into turn and lacked late needed final kick in drive. TELL TALE FRIEND set pace along inside, continued leader by slight margin in backstretch, challenged by JOES BLAZING AARON going into turn, vied along inside and could not keep up pace in stretch. EL ROMANO settled in early stages, made a bid in stretch and slightly gained position. ADMIRAL PERRY stalked front runners along backstretch, made a bid between rivals midstretch and flattened out in late drive. BLUEDACIOUS tracked top two front runners racing near inside, continued within contention nearing far turn and began to falter at top of the lane. WHERE'S THE BABY raced three wide in turn and never menaced in stretch.
