BELLE'S APPEAL set the pace racing just off the rail, then drew off through the stretch under urging. EXTENDED APPLAUSE, checked when caught in tight early, angled in to save ground, made a run into the stretch and proved second best. PRECIOSA V. chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. FORTUESQUE, outrun early, improved her position. JUNIQUE, swerved in at the start, moved up quickly to chase the pace and faded. PAPANIKA was no factor while four wide on the turn. PAVED IN GOLD, stumbled badly at the start, hustled up into contention and gave way.
