LILY'S AFFAIR set the pace under pressure along the inside, then drew clear when set down for the drive. GOLDEN MINING unhurried early, advanced three wide on the turn to reach contention but was no match for the winner in the drive. SUPERBOWL PICC rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the turn, then outfinished the others. MAMA ELLA outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and lacked a rally. MYCUPOFTEA well placed into the stretch, lacked a late response. DATING GAME wearing a nasal strip, showed early foot along the rail and faded. AGGRESSIVE BROAD forced the pace around the turn and stopped.
