JO JO'S BOY raced just off the pace while saving ground, rallied along the inside to challenge in upper stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and prevailed in a hard drive. KALU broke slowly, was unhurried for a half, closed the gap while four wide on the turn then closed strongly from outside but could not get up. BOASTFUL never far back, closed the gap on the turn, gained a slim lead in upper stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded late. HEROIC SIGHT was reserved for six furlongs, advanced four wide on the turn and rallied mildly. WOODSNWATERS failed to threaten while improving his position. THESIS raced up close while four wide to the turn and tired. SUNSHINE MESSENGER (GB) went evenly. FINDER set the pace along the rail to the turn and checked while tiring in the stretch. BUBBA'S COLORS was never a factor while four wide. THEBOYS failed to menace after breaking slowly. CLEAR NORTH chased along the rail for five furlongs and gave way. RADIANT RUNAWAY checked at the start and was never close thereafter.
