FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Closes Wednesday, December 27, 2006 with a fee of \$100, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. (\$25,000 from the F.T.B.O.A. Stakes Fund to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second and 11% to third to Registered Florida Breds placing First, Second or Third.) The owner of the winner to receive \$45,000, \$15,000 to second, \$8,250 to third, \$4,500 to fourth and \$2,250 to fifth. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-Winners of \$24,000 twice since September 1, 2006, allowed 2 lbs.; \$24,000 once since November 1, 2006, 4 lbs. Closed Wednesday, December 27, 2006 with 31 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 84 feet).

Footnotes

CLASSIC CAMPAIGN reserved early, steadied in behind rivals leaving the far turn, then rallied and split rivals to be just up at the wire. DREADNAUGHT rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied along the outside to just miss. SAINT STEPHEN stalked the pace four wide, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole but was edged to the wire in the final strides. KISS THE KID set the pace off the rail into the stretch, responded when headed by SAINT STEPHEN at the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. GIN AND SIN allowed to settle, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. BALLAST (IRE) tracked the pace along the inside, eased out and made a run to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. INTERPATATION unhurried early, angled out in the stretch and found his best stride late. MINISTER'S JOY outrun early, angled wide in the stretch and gained some ground without threatening. GIANT WRECKER rank under restraint in the early going, stalked the pace into the stretch and tired. OLD DODGE (BRZ) chased the pace three wide into the stretch and faltered. ECCLESIASTIC off slowly, chased the pace along the rail, moved through inside KISS THE KID to try that rival around the far turn and into the stretch, then faded.
