SENATOR BECK reserved along the inside after hitting the gate at the start, swung out for the stretch run, then lugged back in to the rail and rallied to be up in time. AMBARONA stalked the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the far turn, rallied to open a clear lead in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. AMIE LYNN reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals to gain the show. FABULOUSLY RIPPED unhurried while saving ground, angled

wide in the stretch and improved her position. IVES HILL failed to menace. NATALIE'S GOAL chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. STARSHIP SATA was through after six furlongs. CENTRIQUE raced in striking position into the far turn, then faltered. LADY EDERLE was outrun while racing four wide. ON TIME AGAIN was caught out wide around the first turn, chased the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded. LAURIE'S CHOICE clipped heels soon after the start and was never close. THE WINTER QUEEN set the pace along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then had nothing left.
