MAJOR MARVEL away well and pressed the early pace, edged up to WHATSUPNOTMUCH in backstretch, vied along outside of rival in turn, took command in upper stretch, took lead by narrow margin midstretch and held off late challengers under driving finish. TOM KITTEN allowed to settle in near back of rivals in backstretch, began to gain position nearing far turn, raced four wide at top of the lane, continued to gain ground 2wd in stretch and was up for second in final strides. MIDNITE SILVER stalked front runners in early stages, advanced position three wide at top of the lane, set sights on MAJOR MARVEL midstretch and slightly weakened leaving eighth pole. SIR RABBIT raced near the back of the field in backstretch, steadily began to pick it up nearing far turn and continued to gain position in the stretch. SR. HENRY stalked between rivals in backstretch and steadily gained position two to three wide in the stretch. PECKY'S BOY pressed pace in opening quarter, slightly settled back off lead, remained along inside and steadily weakened after half mile. JUDGE WELL reserved two off inside in backstretch, slightly improved position but was never serious threat. BREAK UP THE GAME stalked along rail in backstretch, continued to save ground near inside in stretch and lacked late response. WHATSUPNOTMUCH took command early and set pace

along inside, challenged by rivals heading into far turn and had nothing left late. KID CURRY stalked three off the inside in backstretch and failed to be menace in the drive. ALLARD raced up close between rivals in early stages and began to falter in middle of the stretch. SWEETSOUTHERNMAN lacked response throughout.
