POWERFUL NATION, unhurried early, rallied four wide on the far turn, gained command approaching the eighth pole and drew clear. RAP AND DANCE, reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn and was up for the place. SOFT SENORITA, well placed, drew even between horses at the top of the stretch but was outfinished. GO DONNA GO saved ground and faltered. MERCURY DIRECT chased the pace inside, gained a slim lead on the far turn and tired. CORPORATE MISS, up close early, faded. OPEN LINE was no threat. O K BUT HOWABOUTME sprinted to a clear lead, then was tiring when steadied on the far turn and stopped.
