Footnotes

KEYED ENTRY showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew away when set down for the drive. MINER'S LAMP chased the pace four wide, made a run at the winner leaving the turn but was no match for that rival in the drive while edging FORMAL APPEAL for the place. The latter, chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leader racing into the stretch, then couldn't stay with that rival and was outgamed for the place. HIGH CHATEAU off slowly, tracked the leaders into the stretch and tired. ANGLERS REEF unhurried early, failed to menace while improving his position in the drive. WESTERN SLAM pressed the pace along the rail to midway of the turn and faltered. EL QUIXOTE was not a factor after breaking slowly. ARMAMENT raced three wide and faded. AWESOME IDEA was outrun. TRIPLE STEP off slowly, rushed up along the rail to reach contention racing into the turn but had nothing left.
