**Footnotes**

HOPES AND DREAMS chased the pace, took over at the top of the stretch when MIRACLE MOMENT bolted, then was fully extended to remain clear to the wire. REIGNING EMERALD in good position, rallied to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't get to the winner late while clearly second best. AMBLING allowed to settle after being caught in tight at the start, swung out for the stretch run and finished willingly for the show. DIVA rated off the pace, advanced along the inside to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't gain late. MISS PEACHTREE reserved in striking position off the pace, lacked a late response. MIRACLE MOMENT quickly sprinted to a clear lead while angling over to the inside, got out a bit entering the far turn, was angled back in to continue making the pace, then bolted at the top of the stretch and gave way. CHRISTMAS JONES chased the pacesetter into the far turn and tired. GOLD FACTOR failed to menace. ANN HARRIS was no factor after being steadied in the early going. NOT POETIC was outrun. STRAIGHT GIRL well placed early, faltered. LA NEES showed little.
