Footnotes

HOLDEN CHAMPAGNE rated off the pace after being steadied in the run to the first turn, angled outside the leaders leaving the far turn and rallied to be up late. KENDRICK'S PATSY tracked the pace four wide, rallied to gain a slim lead inside the eighth pole but couldn't hold off the winner late while saving the place. SKY LASS outrun early, split rivals in the stretch and rallied to be up for the show. IS THIS GOOD reserved off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and closed ground late to just miss the show. SUGAR BOOGER set the pace along the rail to inside the eighth pole and gave way. LADY HARTWOOD tracked the pace along the rail, was steadied when trapped behind the leaders in the stretch and outfinished. SHE CAN PUNCH stalked the pace three wide, angled out and advanced to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. RARE TREASURE chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leader on the far turn and into the stretch, then tired. MAGNOLIA LIGHT failed to menace. LEGS AN DIAMONDS prompted the pace outside SUGAR BOOGER to the far turn and tired. REMEMBERIN ELEANOR was not a factor. PAVONES was through early.
