DISCREET DANCER set the pace outside HOLLYWOOD SCRIPT to midway of the turn, then drew off under a hand ride. NECK 'N NECK tracked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and gained the place while no match for the winner. TWO IS TO MANY chased the pace three wide around the turn and gave way. ONE SOCK DOWN chased the pace off the rail into the stretch, then tired. A BOY NAMED EM failed to menace. DA VINCI was caught in tight at the start, raced four wide and faltered. IN THE BEAT was outrun. HERE WE GO JOE showed early foot, raced three wide around the turn and faded. HOLLYWOOD SCRIPT pressed the pace along the rail into the turn, then had nothing left.
