**Footnotes**

SHANIKO stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over nearing the stretch, then drew off under urging. EDDINGTON tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to prove second best while no match for the winner. RADIANT CAT allowed to settle, raced four wide on the far turn and closed to gain the show while never a threat to the winner. CHIPPEWA TRAIL stalked the pace, slipped through along the rail to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. AFAR steadied in traffic on the first turn, advanced off the rail on the far turn, then steadied in behind EDDINGTON nearing the eighth pole and tired. JOMA was never a factor after being outrun early. FORMAL FINISH in good position, was steadied along the in the early going, around the first turn and into the backstretch, remained in contention into the stretch, then steadied again in traffic approaching the eighth pole and faltered. KOLOSZAR tracked the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and faded. KAPELLMISTER was outrun while saving ground. SKY MISSILE off slowly, showed little. GREAT CHARISMA set the pace off the rail into the far turn and stopped.
