SARATOGA COUNTY outrun early, advanced four wide around the turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to draw clear under urging. LIMEHOUSE reserved early, saved ground around the turn, angled out in the stretch and closed to prove second best. ALL HAIL STORMY chased the pace, moved up on the turn to vie for the lead three wide to midstretch, then gave way. WANDO outrun early, passed tired rivals in the drive. CHOOSE failed to menace after bobbling at the start. VOODOO chased the leaders into the stretch, angled out and tired. SHAKE YOU DOWN vied for the lead outside STRENGTH AND HONOR to midstretch, then faltered. STRENGTH AND HONOR vied for the lead along the inside to midstretch and faded. THUNDER TOUCH reserved off the pace, steadied in behind VOODOO in early stretch and stopped. DEPUTY STORM showed early foot, raced four wide on the turn, then had nothing left for the drive.
