BATTLE PLAN stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then drew clear. JET SET VINNY pressed the pace outside CROSS VILLAGE, gained a slim lead from that rival nearing the quarter pole, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. COLORS FLYING unhurried after stumbling at the start, raced four wide around the turn and closed with a mild rally to be up for the show. RODDICKTON stalked the pace into the stretch and gave way. STAR PLAYER reserved in striking position off the pace, lacked a late response. NOWHERE TO HIDE off slowly, was not a factor. CHIEF BEAR raced in contention three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. CROSS VILLAGE set the pace under pressure along the rail to nearing the quarter pole and faltered. RAYBERN'S GOLD broke slowly, showed early foot along the inside and faded.
