Footnotes

SLEEPLESS KNIGHT unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied to be up late. ROGUE VICTORY outrun after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied to be up for the place. GUYS REWARD reserved off the pace, was forced to alter course outside a wall of rivals in the stretch, then closed well to just miss the place. JUST PLAYIN AROUND set the pace along the rail, increased his advantage in midstretch, then gave way late. ASPHALT stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and was outfinished. VANQUISHER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and finished willingly. OLYMPIC ELECTION (BRZ) stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch but didn't do enough late. JIMMY SIMMS well placed in behind the leaders, was attempting to make a run when blocked and steadied in behind rivals late and failed to recover. BANROCK failed to menace. OUR CHAMPION chased the pacesetter into the stretch and tired. SAINT DYNIFORMER was not a factor. SARTO up close while saving ground for the first half mile, faltered.
