FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free Nomination by Wednesday, December 29, 2009, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$60,000; \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made on Wednesday January 5, at a fee of \$5,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight : 123 lbs.

Non-winners of a grade I in 2010 allowed 2 lbs; a graded stakes or \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010 4 lbs., \$45,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2009-2010 earnings. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, December 29, 2010 with 16 nominations.

SOARING EMPIRE never far back, moved up to engage MORNING LINE midway of the turn, edged away from that rival in early stretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. RULE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly to be up for the place while unable to get to the winner. MORNING LINE set the pace racing well off the rail, eased to the inside on the turn, responded when challenged by SOARING EMPIRE but couldn't stay with that rival in early stretch and was outfinished for the place. TACKLEBERRY bobbled at the start, stalked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. DREAM MAESTRO failed to menace after being outrun early. CAIXA ELETRONICA tracked the pace to the quarter pole, then faltered.
