TUBROK wearing a nasal strip, tracked the pace, moved to take over three wide on the far turn and was fully extended to prevail. SPRING STREET rated off the pace, angled four wide entering the stretch, rallied to reach the leader in deep stretch but was edged to the wire. LAMBEAU LEAP hit the gate at the start, saved ground into the stretch and outfinished the others. UNCLE ABBIE rated off the pace, passed tired rivals in the drive. CARDINAL VERSE wearing a nasal strip, was unhurried early, advanced four wide on the far turn to reach contention but couldn't sustain his bid. GENERAL GRANT outrun early, improved his position in the drive. MT. BELLEWOOD wearing a nasal strip, bobbled at the start, steadied in traffic early and was not a factor. LOVERINEVERYPORT was outrun after being bothered early. PURE CLASS was through early. GOLDEN CONCORDE wearing a nasal strip, stalked the pace into the stretch, then was steadied when he ducked in at the gap and faded. UPPER HAND faded while saving ground. CARIBBEAN RIVER sprinted to a clear lead along the hedge and stopped in the drive.
