STAKES Marshua's River S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Closes December 31, 2004 with a fee of \$25, \$350 to pass the entry box and \$350 additional to start. Supplemental nominations may be made on January 7, 2005 at a fee of \$1,000, which includes entry and start fees. Weights: Three Year Olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Winners of a Sweepstakes on the turf since October 1, 2004, 2 lbs. additional.; Non-winners of \$24,000 twice since September 1, 2004, allowed 2 lbs.; \$28,000 once since November 1, 2004, 4 lbs.; three races other than Maiden or Claiming, 6 lbs. This event will be limited to 12 starters. (High Weights on the scale Preferred). Total earnings in 2004-2005 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses with equal weight (on the scale). Closed December 31, 2004 with 32 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).





Footnotes

ANGELA'S LOVE set the pace along the rail, drew clear on the far turn, then remained clear to the wire while drifting out late under right handed pressure. DELTA PRINCESS unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. SNOWDROPS (GB) reserved racing along the inside, steadied in behind DAKOTA LIGHT on the backstretch, came out to split rivals in the stretch and gained the show. GALLOPING GAL outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed ground late without threatening. OCEAN SILK allowed to settle, angled four wide on the far turn and improved her position. MARWOOD stalked the winner into the stretch and gave way. MYSTERY ITSELF well placed in behind the leaders, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. DAKOTA LIGHT reserved off the pace, was steadied when caught in traffic in the stretch and failed to recover. JACQUI'S PROMISE reserved early, advanced between horses on the far turn to reach contention, then faltered. JENNASILPRINCESS chased the pace into the far turn and faded. SOMETHING VENTURED was outrun. HOPELESSLY DEVOTED chased the pace along the inside into the far turn, stopped, was eased in the final eighth and collapsed after the finish. (The rail on the turf course was set at 72 feet).
