Footnotes

QUIET ALL AMERICAN raced with the early pace, eased back off the leaders racing down the backstretch, came on again four wide to gain a slim lead at the quarter pole and continued on gamely to hold off DESERT LORD. The latter, off slowly, tracked the pace four wide into the stretch, eased in to make a run at QUIET ALL AMERICAN through the final eighth but was edged to the wire. MOE MAN reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the show. CRAVIN CADEN chased the pace five wide into the stretch but couldn't gain late. SYSTEMIC RISK vied for the lead three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. KEROUAC allowed to settle after breaking slowly, advanced along the inside to loom a threat leaving the turn, then faltered. KEY TO THE EMPIRE outrun along the rail, steadied when unable to get through inside KEROUAC in the stretch and never threatened. READY TO DAZZLE vied for the lead off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faded.
