STAKES Marshua's River S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Wednesday December 29, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth.

Supplemental nominations may be at time of entry at a fee of \$5,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 124 lbs.

Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2010-2011 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2010-2011 4 lbs., \$45,000 at a mile or over since August 1, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2009-2011 earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, December 29, 2010 with 44 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 96 feet).

JUSTAROUNDMIDNIGHT (IRE) outrun early, split rivals on the far turn while moving into contention, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run and rallied to be up in time. PERSUADING set the pace along the inside to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides while holding the place. NEVER RETREAT rated off the pace while racing between horses, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. CHEROKEE QUEEN

reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and finished willingly while just being edged for the show. TRIP FOR A. J. chased PERSUADING into the stretch and was outfinished. WILD MIA well placed, advanced along the inside to reach contention leaving the far turn but didn't do enough late. MARY'S FOLLIES allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and gained ground late without threatening. QUEBRADA SHINER (ARG) bobbed at the start, tracked the leaders into the stretch and weakened. STREET GOSSIP unhurried early, failed to menace. C. S. SILK tracked the pace four wide to midway of the far turn, then tired. KISS MINE chased the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered. SWEETEST SONG raced five wide and faded.
