IOYA TWO was in tight between horses in the early stages, launched a rally four wide on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch and drew off under mild urging. HERE'S TO YOU was never far back, made a run to challenge on the turn but was no match for the winner. WESTERN WIND was unhurried for five furlongs and rallied mildly while four wide. RATATUIA (GB) improved her position with a mild late rally. DOE RIVER raced between horses to the turn and lacked a further response. MYSTERY PLACE checked in the early stages, faded after five furlongs. MARY THE SECOND (IRE) forced the pace from outside and tired. DANCWAY was never a factor. BUCKINGHAM BABE was used up setting the early pace. QUIXOTE'S HOPE chased the leaders for five furlongs and gave way.
