BALLADO HILL bumped with DOLL TO CALL several times at the start, steadied in behind SIGNIFICANT RISK on the first turn, chased that rival along the rail, steadied inside that rival twice in the stretch, then slipped through and drew clear late. SIGNIFICANT RISK bumped with DOLL TO CALL a couple of times at the start, set the pace along the inside into the stretch, came off the rail for the drive and couldn't stay with the winner late while just saving the place. VARAKA stalked the pace into the stretch, then didn't do enough late while just missing the place. EIGHTYFIVEBROADST allowed to settle, saved ground throughout and closed with a mild rally. WEAR raced in striking position between horses into the stretch, eased out for the drive and lacked a late response. BOOM BAH YAY rank and steadied in the early going, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. CHORUS GIRL chased the pace three wide into the far turn and tired. SPECTACULARELEGANZ was outrun. CLASSIC BORN showed little after breaking poorly. DOLL TO CALL was bounced around and steadied from between rivals at the start, raced four wide on the far turn and faded.
