ROYAL ASSAULT rated off the pace, angled five wide on the turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and edged away. CAPIAS reserved early, raced five wide on the turn and closed to be up for the place. BIDLLESS chased the pace four wide, made a run to reach even terms for command in the stretch but was outfinished. COAXED vied for the lead three wide around the turn, continued to contest the pace to inside the eighth pole and weakened. LEADING THE PARADE outrun after being caught in tight early, raced five wide on the turn and improved his position. STEAMBOAT SPRINGS failed to menace. ELIJAH'S SONG reserved early, advanced into contention along the inside on the turn, then tired in the drive. TANDY LAKES showed brief foot and gave way. JULIAN'S COMMANDER vied for the lead between horses and faltered. THE WARDEN'S PRIZE was outrun while saving ground. PISTOLS'S WILDCARD vied for the lead along the inside to midway of the turn and faded.
