CUPID'S COMET was well placed for a half, launched a rally from outside entering the stretch then wore down MISS VERMONT JET in the final eighth. MISS VERMONT JET bobbled at the start, sprinted clear in the early stages, dug in when challenged on the turn, battled heads apart leaving the furlong marker but couldn't stay with the winner in the late stages. MINNIE'S BRAT settled just off the early pace, rallied four wide on the turn then rallied mildly to gain a share. MISS GLITTERMAN never far back, was taken in hand briefly on the far turn, raced just behind the leader while saving ground on the turn, slipped through along the rail to challenge in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her rally. M. D.'S EMPRESS taken in hand early, failed to mount a serious rally. ANGELA'S TUNE saved ground early for a half, swung out in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. FOOLISH PROSPECT was never a factor after breaking slowly.
