Footnotes

STARSHIP JODI allowed to settle after breaking slowly, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to be just up at the wire. MISS NEPAL unhurried early, rallied along the rail to gain the lead in deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. SANSANNAH reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the place while being outfinished by the winner. ROJO'S TUNE set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run, then weakened in the final strides. SIMPLY IMPRESSIVE tracked the pace into the stretch and finished willingly. FRIENDLY SELECTION outrun early, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and closed with a belated rally. ROGUE rated off the pace, saved ground while advancing into the stretch but didn't do enough late. ZUBANI trailed after being steadied at the start, raced three wide around the far turn and closed ground late. SETTLING SEAS steadied from close quarters at the start, tracked the leaders three wide, made a run to reach the attending position in the stretch, then gave way. TIGER GIRL chased the pacesetter to the top of the stretch and tired. SPRING BEAUTY was no factor while racing three wide. GATOR'S TRACKS broke to the outside, tracked the leaders four wide into the far turn, then faltered.
