Footnotes

MISS JULIA settled just off the early pace, steadily advanced position along rail, edged up along outside of top two leaders in the turn, raced three wide at the top of the lane, took command in upper stretch and drew off. MIA'S DOUBLE vied between rivals for early lead, continued just off JEREZANA in backstretch, inched back up to lead heading into turn, vied along outside then between, could not hold off MISS JULIA midstretch and finished clear second. STARSHIP TACTICAL was allowed to settle along inside in early stages, steadily gained position heading for home, raced two to three wide into lane and mildly gained position late. WILDCAT HONEY stalked the front runners two to three off rail, slightly gained position in backstretch, raced five wide at the top of lane and lacked final kick to make serious impact. PYRITE MOON tracked the pace in early stages, began to inch up to leaders along outside in the turn, floated out five at top of lane and had nothing left in late drive. FLOPODOPOLUS unhurried in early stages and settled in near the back of rivals, asked for response heading for home, swung out three wide at the top of lane, slightly gained position but flattened out in late stretch. STARSHIP GALACTICA reserved in opening stages racing in back of the pack, slightly gained position along inside going into turn but lacked late needed rally in drive to make impact. JEREZANA took command in opening quarter by slight margin over rivals, began to vie for lead heading into far turn, continued to try and dig in upper stretch but could not keep up pace and steadily retreated. THE RIGHT BUTTON urged up along inside after start, could not match strides with

leaders, settled back slightly and steadily weakened after. ROOT FOR THE CAT raced evenly near the back of rivals and lacked response when asked. IT'S A D'WILDCAT dropped back to last after opening quarter and showed little after.
