Footnotes

SI SENORA stalked the front runners in early stages, advanced position three wide in the turn, raced four wide at top of lane, edged up to SHIMMERING TINA midstretch, vied along outside and dug in late to prevail. SHIMMERING TINA took command by narrow margin in opening quarter, slightly widened margin in backstretch, felt pressure from SI SENORA going into turn, began to duel for lead along inside, continued to dig in gamely but could not match strides with rival before wire. KRISTINA'S SLEW stalked front runners along inside in early stages, continued to save ground along rail in stretch, angled out slightly in drive and steadily gain ground to wire. PHOEBE MOON unhurried in early stages, asked to pick up pace nearing far turn, raced five wide into lane and improved position in the stretch. SWEET LIKE SUGAR bobbled and broke out slightly at start, lost momentum and raced in back of rivals, continued

reserved in the backstretch, picked up pace in the stretch but was too late to make serious impact. SWEET AND VICIOUS settled in early stages, raced two off inside in the turn and lacked strong late kick to make impact. ELSIE'S PRINCESS made a bid between rivals in the turn, slightly gained position but was not a serious threat. ALTAMAR raced near the back of rivals in early stages, continued along rail in stretch and was never a factor. BON BON raced within contention in the backstretch, was four wide at top of the lane and faltered in the stretch. KATHY'S RIBBONS raced three to four wide in lane and failed to be a menace. ADELA'S SONG tracked the pace in the backstretch, raced five wide at the top of the lane and had nothing left in stretch. THE PIA ANGEL raced up close and tracked the pace in early stages and had nothing left after half mile.
