Footnotes

MAJESTIC RIVER raced just off pacesetter in opening stages, continued to press pace in the backstretch, edged up along outside of ANTIPATHY nearing far turn, vied along outside into the lane, shook free midstretch and steadily drew clear to wire. ANTIPATHY took command by slight margin in opening quarter, continued to set the pace in backstretch, challenged by MAJESTIC RIVER heading into far turn, dueled for lead into lane and could not match strides with rival in late drive. DREAMLICIOUS stumbled at start, quickly recovered, tracked the top two pacesetters in the backstretch, asked for response right handed in the turn and continued steady bid to the wire. PEARLS FOR GIRLS stalked the front runners along inside in early stages, raced two off inside in the upper stretch and lacked final kick in the drive. DIAMOND MAKER allowed to settle along rail in the backstretch, angled out four wide in the lane and finished evenly in late drive. GOOD NEWS TODAY stalked front runners three off inside in backstretch, floated out five wide into lane and lacked rally in stretch. E B RYDER stalked near inside in early stages, raced two to three wide into lane and failed to rally to be a threat in the drive. BIEN ROULEE raced in the back of rivals throughout and failed to make a bid.
