BIG JOHN B in good position, rallied belatedly to be up in the final strides under pressure. UNITED STATES WON chased the speed into the stretch, took over in the drive and gave way in deep stretch. KID LIGHTNING void of early speed, rallied belatedly to gain the show. RED VINE unhurried early, rallied belatedly. TWIGAZURI STRAIT well placed, lacked the needed late response. SECRET BID allowed to settle, rallied mildly. ALICANTINO stalked the pace three wide, took over briefly on the final turn and weakened in the drive. AMPERSAND rallied belatedly after showing no speed. PIRATE'S PLEASURE set the pace saving ground into the final turn and tired. PICEANCE steadied entering the first turn in traffic, prompted the speed along the inside and faded. CYTHEREAN faltered after being well positioned. DR. CHASE trailed.
