HURRICANE BERTIE showed speed along the rail, was outmoved on the turn, came again to reach the lead, then dueled with MARLEY VALE through the stretch and edged that rival to the wire. MARLEY VALE advanced three wide on the turn to reach even terms for command at the top of the stretch, dueled with HURRICANE BERTIE to the wire and just missed. CASSIDY was reserved off the pace, then rallied mildly to best the rest. VEGAS PROSPECTOR outran early, improved her position without threatening. EXTENDED APPLAUSE allowed to settle, lacked a rally. LUCKY AGAIN vied for the lead, edged away midway of the turn, then tired in the stretch run. GOLD PRINCESS chased the pace four wide around the turn and tired.
