HOOK AND LADDER chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and drew away under urging. KIPPERSCOPE set the pace off the rail, opened a clear lead on the turn, then was no match for the winner while proving second best. RED'S HONOR chased the pace along the rail into the stretch and weakened. ISTINTAJ reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and lacked a late response. SILVER JET failed to menace after being outrun early. WINNIE'S POOH BEAR raced in striking position around the turn and tired. TEMPERED APPEAL bobbled at the start, saved ground around the turn and faltered. BRERETON unhurried early, steadied from between rivals on the turn and faded.
