MAIZELLE chased the pace, rallied to take over in early stretch and drew away under urging. PLUTONIC unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. BOOTERY reserved off the pace, angled four wide on the turn while moving into contention but had no late response and was edged for the place. CUABA tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. BROKEN ROMANCE failed to menace. LIGHTS OUT ANGEL was not a factor. MERYL'S SPIRIT set the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. DIAMOND SPIRIT well placed early, faltered leaving the turn. HONEY HARBOUR chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded.
