SUGAR SWIRL rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the turn, moved to catch RGIRLDOESN'TBLUFF nearing the eighth pole, then drew clear under a hand ride. RGIRLDOESN'TBLUFF showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while clearly second best. BEREBA chased the leaders along the rail into the stretch, then tired. QUALITY AFFAIR chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. MARINA BALLERINA showed brief foot and faded. RUNNING LASS, off slowly, was always outrun. PRINCESS JANIE showed early foot and stopped.
