**Footnotes**

CUMULONIMBLE reserved racing along the rail, was steadied to avoid running up on KISS THE STARS on the far turn, slipped through inside that rival while rallying to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and prevailed. KISS THE STARS stalked the pace along the inside, came out a bit while moving to take over at the top of the stretch, made the pace to nearing the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner while holding the place. HERE TO WIN (BRZ) allowed to settle, raced four wide while advancing around the far turn, then steadied when trapped in behind NEW NORMAL in the stretch, came outside that rival and finished willingly to be up for the show. SUBMISSION (GB) outrun after breaking awkwardly, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. NEW NORMAL stalked the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but had no late response. MILLENNIA unhurried early, advanced to reach contention on the far turn, then flattened out. PRIZE INFORMANT set the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, then gave way. MUTUALLY BENEFIT chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. EXCHANGE FUNDS rated off the pace, raced five wide around the far turn, then faltered. SALARY DRIVE off slowly, was no factor while racing five wide.
