Footnotes

STARSHIP TRUFFLES raced just off pace in opening stages, edged up to the lead shortly after, vied with rivals briefly, took command heading into far turn and remained unchallenged to wire. FOREVER CANDY settled in and stalked the pace in opening stages, made a bid between rivals in backstretch, steadily gained position, swung out three wide into turn, could not catch winner but finished clear second. COURTNEY RYAN stalked three wide in early stages, began to pick up pace along outside of rivals in backstretch, raced three wide at the top of the lane and continued a steady bid to the wire. MAE RULER raced up close to lead in opening stages, vied briefly with rivals, could not match strides and slightly weakened along rail at the top of the stretch. REDFOXLEY DOROTHY was urged up along inside after the break, chased front runners along rail and steadily began to weaken nearing far turn. CAPITALISM AT RISK took command by slight margin in opening quarter, challenged shortly after, briefly vied for lead, could not keep up pace and began to weaken after half mile. FOREVER NOBLE made a brief bid in opening quarter, settled back to last, floated out five wide in the turn and lacked response in the drive.
