Footnotes

RHYTHM OF THE MOON stalked the pace in opening stages, began to inch up to lead along outside in the turn, raced three wide into lane, dug in late and kicked clear in late stretch. VERO'S HERO allowed to settle in early stages, made a bid for leaders heading into turn, angled out five wide, rallied along outside in the stretch and quickly gained ground to wire. BIG ARA K stalked the pace in the backstretch, made a bid for lead nearing far turn, raced between rivals in stretch and just missed place in final strides. RIMAL AL SAHARA allowed to settle in early stages, steadily began to advance position, raced four wide in turn and steadily gained position in stretch. BEA TOP QUALITY pressed pace in early stages, continued just off lead nearing the turn, continued within contention in upper stretch and could not keep up pace in late drive. FATHOM'S END tracked the pace in early stages, continued to stalk along inside and came up empty in stretch. FAST STACK tracked the pace along rail, edged up to lead, vied briefly with rivals and could not keep up pace in late drive. RIVERSTAR settled along rail in early stages and passed tiring rivals in stretch. PENTLAND took command in opening quarter, challenged by rivals shortly

after, slightly settled back and steadily began to fade heading into turn. BLUE BUSINESS raced in back of rivals in backstretch and failed to be a threat in the stretch. PUT IT BACK TIGER chased the early pace along inside in opening quarter and had nothing left after. ROCKY SPRING showed little throughout.
