Footnotes

INAUGURATE allowed to settle in and stalk the pace in early stages, made a bid nearing the far turn, quickly gained ground in late stretch and was up in time to prevail. NAYARRA (IRE) raced just off the leader in opening stages, continued to press the pace in the backstretch, asked to make a bid for lead heading into far turn, edged up to lead, matched strides late and could not hold off late charging INAUGURATE. KIBOSH settled in stalking the pace in early stages, asked to pick up pace going into far turn, gained position in the late stretch but was too late to prevail. LADY'S LUNAR LUCK was reserved in early stages racing near the back of the pack, began to advance in upper stretch and gained ground to the wire. SPOOKY KITTEN tracked the pace near inside in backstretch, made a bid and slightly gained position but flattened out in late drive. GEISHA GAL was unhurried in early stages racing in the back of rivals,

made a bid nearing the far turn and improved position in stretch. DIVINE LUCK took command early and continued to set pace along inside, challenged by rivals heading into far turn, vied briefly for lead and could not keep up pace in late drive. TIPSY was unhurried in early stages and passed tiring rivals in stretch. STORMY N' SLY stalked the pace in the early going, made a bid and slightly gained position and flattened out in the upper stretch. CLEAR DANGER stalked the pace in opening stages and began to weaken after half mile. WISE MOMENT settled in opening quarter, made a bid and gained position but had nothing left after half mile. HALO'S GATE dropped back to last after opening quarter and lacked response in drive.
