LADY IZ WAITIN made the pace along the inside, then drew off around the far turn and through the stretch under urging. SUNNY'S LOVE reserved early, angled to the outside for the stretch run and rallied to prove second best. ABSOLUT QUEEN well placed, advanced to loom a threat three wide on the far turn, then tired. LADY JANELL outrun early, passed tired rivals. JOAN'S MONEYMAKER chased the pacesetter into the stretch and faltered. HOUR DANCER up close while saving ground, faltered in the drive. QUEEN PALM wearing a nasal strip, chased the pace three wide into the far turn and faded. CAROL'S TURN wearing a nasal strip, was not a factor. MAMA ROSE showed little. BELLE'S GEMINI was never close.
