CALLER'S IMAGE off slowly, moved up to chase the pace three wide, rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away under pressure. SEMINOLE GAL chased the pace off the rail, moved to gain a slim lead on the turn but couldn't match strides with the winner late while continuing on with good courage for the place. CHASE THE CHARMER showed speed along the inside, responded when headed on the turn, continued to contest the pace to inside the eighth pole and weakened. J J SILVER BLUSH tracked the leaders along the inside into the stretch, then had no response when asked. NAN'S ROSE reserved in striking position off the pace, lacked a late response. MISTI LIGHT showed brief speed, dropped back quickly when she lost her action racing down the backstretch, lost her action again on the turn and was eased in the final eighth. SCAMP ALONG showed little after breaking slowly and was eased in the final eighth.
