Footnotes

BRAZILIAN tracked the pace after breaking slowly, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to reach even terms for command just inside the eighth pole, then dueled with QUIES and just edged that rival to the wire. QUIES reserved early, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to reach even terms for command with BRAZILIAN inside the eighth pole, then dueled with that rival and just missed. THETACTICS OFDANCE stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside MOON BERRY to reach near even terms for command in midstretch but was outfinished. PLEASE TAKE ME OUT chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead outside MOON BERRY leaving the far turn, made the pace to the eighth pole and gave way. CHARACTER BUILDER raced in striking position into the stretch and had no late response. MOON BERRY (BRZ) hopped at the start, moved up quickly to gain the lead, made the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, responded when headed by PLEASE TAKE ME OUT, continued on well to past the eighth pole and tired. OCTOBER WINDS stalked the pace three wide, then faltered leaving the far turn. BRIDAL PATH was outrun. MISS NASHWAN (IRE) was not a factor. ALISA'S HOPE was through early.
