YACHATS vied for the lead outside BEHOLDEN into the stretch, then drew clear under pressure. BEHOLDEN vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while saving the place. GLEAMING ELEGANCE chased the pace three wide around the turn and weakened. SMART N PRETTY chased the leaders along the inside, angled out for the drive and couldn't keep pace with the top ones. DIAMOND SPIRIT reserved after she dwelt at the start, saved ground and improved her position. MYLLMONEYMAKER outrun after breaking slowly, swung out for the drive and passed tired rivals. MUTAKAWAY failed to menace. HAPPY HONOREE tired from good position. REASON TO REJOICE chased the leaders three wide around the turn and faltered. ELUSIVE SUGAR well placed early, raced five wide on the turn and faded. HOME BEFOR MIDNITE off slowly, was not a factor. DEADWOOD DAME was done early.
