FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Closed Thursday, January 5, 2006 with 31 nominations at a fee of \$100, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed. The owner of the winner to receive \$45,000, \$15,000 to second, \$8,250 to third, \$4,500 to fourth and \$2,250 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 117 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Winners of a Sweepstakes on the turf since October 1, 2005, 2 lbs. additional.; Non-winners of \$24,000 twice since September 1, 2005, allowed 2 lbs.; \$24,000 once since November 1, 2005, 4 lbs. This event will be limited to 12 starters. (High Weights on the scale Preferred). Total earnings in 2005-2006 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses with equal weight (on the scale). (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 60 feet). 

MY LORDSHIP stalked the pace, moved to gain a slim lead in early stretch, responded when challenged by ON THE BUS and was fully extended to prevail. ON THE BUS stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the winner in the stretch but was outgamed to the wire. NATALIE BEACH (ARG) never far back racing along the rail, angled outside the leaders for room leaving the far turn and closed with a mild response to be up for the show. DYNAMITE LASS reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed ground late to just miss the show. BRUNILDA (ARG) allowed to settle, while saving ground, was caught in traffic on the far turn, angled to the outside for the stretch run and finished willingly to also just miss the show. MALAYSIA (GB) quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail into the stretch, then weakened. A LULU OFA MENIFEE outrun early, saved ground and had no late response. SAUVAGE (FR) rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. COQUINERIE was outrun. CHANCEY LIGHT showed little. CUTE CONNIE chased the pace four wide into the far turn and faltered. LA REINA was no factor when eased late and vanned off.
